Reading

- Before you read, write a prediction of what might happen next. Were you correct?
- Draw a picture of the setting.
- Find interesting words in the story and mark them with a post-it note then look them up in a dictionary.
- Compare 2 of the characters how are they different or similar?
- Compare 2 books you have read how are they different or similar?
- Are any of the events in the story similar to things that have happened to you? Write down how and what happened.
- Read a favourite book you have from home and make an advert for it to recommend it to a friend.


Spelling

- Make up a word search using your spelling words.

- Play hangman with someone using your spelling words.

Maths
