

Swimming Trunks (1 & 2) must be fitted and made of lycra. Swimsuits (3) may also be worn but must be tight/ fitted and made of lycra. These can be bought at Sports Direct, Asda and Amazon and many other shops.

Bermuda or Hawaiian shorts or shorts that are loose fitting (below) are not allowed.



All boys **MUST** wear a swimming cap. Children without caps will not be allowed into the pool.



Children must bring a towel. All swimming kit should be brought in a bag.

No swimming goggles are allowed. Children should **NOT** come wearing their costume – everyone will change at the swimming pool. No jewellery is allowed – please remove any earrings before school.

Girls swimming costumes must be fitted and made of Lycra. Bodysuits may be worn but must be made of stretch nylon/lycra.



Normal leggings made from cotton are not allowed. Any leggings worn must be made from nylon and lycra.



All girls **MUST** wear a swimming cap. Children without caps will not be allowed into the pool. It is helpful if girls come to school with hair tied in a pony tail.

Children must bring a towel.  
All swimming kit should be brought in a bag.

No swimming goggles are allowed.  
Children should **NOT** come wearing their costume – everyone will change at the swimming pool.  
No jewellery is allowed – please remove any earrings before school.
