Swimming Trunks (1 & 2) must be fitted and made of lycra. Swimsuits (3) may also be worn but must be tight/ fitted and made of lycra. These can be bought at Sports Direct, Asda and Amazon and many other shops.

All boys MUST wear a swimming cap. Children without caps will not be allowed into the pool.
