

In English, we will learn the story Jack and the Beanstalk and plan, draft, write, edit and improve our own finding tales. We will write persuasion texts based on our local area.

In Maths, we will use concrete equipment to investigate Fractions and build upon our prior knowledge of Time.

In Science, we will explore what plants need to grow, what the life cycle of a plant is and label the different parts of a plant and its functions.

In Geography, we will explore the physical and human geography of our local area by using and creating maps and planning simple routes around our environment. In Art, we will be focusing on drawing using different techniques and begin to look at 3D form.

In Music, we will explore how music can be used expressively and begin to identify different instruments used in a piece of

In PSHCE, we will be looking at how our lifestyle choices promote growing and changing and what we need to keep healthy.

In PE, we will be taking part in Athletics and Volleyball.

What do we already know?

In Year 2 we have learnt:

- That seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants
- Plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow.
- How to use observational skills to study our school environment.
- To draw a simple map.
- To experiment and choose different media to draw such as crayons and charcoal
- How music can be used to create different moods.

What are we going learn?

- The seven life processes of a plant, the different parts of a plant and their function and the life cycle of a plant.
- How to recreate our local environment on a map using a key to show real features.
- How to Use different media to achieve variations in line, texture, tone, colour, shape and pattern.
