In English, we will learn the story
The Heart and the Bottle by Oliver
Jeffries and write our own versions
of the story. We will also write nonchronological reports based around
our experiences of Covid-19.

In Maths, we will use concrete equipment to investigate place value of three digit numbers including addition and subtraction.

In Science, we will be describing the basic function of the skeletal system and investigating ways in which it provides protection. We will also be setting up simple, comparative tests and reporting our findings.

In Geography, we will be finding out about the geography of St Agnes and Longsight using observation and fieldwork

In Music, we will be listening to, appraising and performing music to communicate emotions.

In PE, we will be taking part in Dance and Invasion Games.

In Art, we will be studying the Expressionist artist Rothko and creating our own Expressionist work

In History, we will using timelines to sequence major pandemics throughout history and comparing and contrasting accounts of the effects of the Covid-19 pandemic.

In PSHE, children will focus on rebuilding relationships and strengthening community bonds.
