In Geography, children will locate where they live on a map. They will understand where Longsight is located within Manchester and the UK. They will be able to identify and name physical and human geography in their local area.

In History, children will understand and be able to sequence significant events in their lifetimes. They will discuss the change from past, present to future.

In Music, Children listen carefully to a variety of different music and relate it to a mood. They respond to the music using whole body movements.
