This Term

This term our topic is – **We are St. Agnes.**

What do we already know?

Welcome

What do we want to learn?

- Geography:** children will locate where they live on a map. They will understand where Londrigit is located within Manchester and the UK. They will be able to identify and name physical and human geography in their local area.
- Art:** children will be able to identify, name and understand primary colours. They will link colours to emotions and create a final piece in the style of Jackson Pollock.
- Computing:** Children will be able to identify and name different types of technology in school and at home. They will understand how to use technology.
- History:** children will understand and be able to sequence significant events in their lifetimes. They will discuss the change from past, present to future.
- PSHE:** children will focus on rebuilding relationships and strengthening community bonds.
- Science:** children will be able to identify a variety of different materials and explore their properties. They will use their findings to decide what materials they would make a bottle out of for their heart and why.
- English:** children will be able to tell the story of The Heart and the Bottle. They will use their phonic knowledge to read and write decodable words and begin to read and write simple sentences, in line with the text.
- Music:** Children listen carefully to a variety of different music and relate it to a mood. They respond to the music using whole body movements.
