This Term



This term our topic is "Rhyme Time" where we be focusing on different nursery rhymes.

While the children are settling into Nursery, we will have a high focus on developing the 3 prime areas of learning.

These are: communication and language

personal, social and emotional development

physical development.

We will support the children during carpet time sessions and during their daily routine in developing the skills they need in order to prepare them for learning.

During this term, we will be observing the children's interests and using this to enhance the environment to engage them in their learning.

The children will be learning how to follow our golden rules this half term.

These are: do be kind and helpful

do be gentle

do listen

do work hard.

In order to help the children remember to follow our golden rules, we have behaviour apples. All children start the day on the green apple – which means they are doing well. If a child does something special and tries hard to follow the rules, their peg will be moved to gold and they will receive a reward. The yellow and red apples are there to remind children to think about the choices they make in Nursery.

Don't Forget...

To label all of your child's belongings, including school uniform, spare clothes, lunch bags, school bags. This helps us to ensure all children take home the correct items at the end of each day.

Please ensure that if your child is on a packed lunch that there is **no nuts including chocolate spread.** This is due to severe allergies.

If you pack grapes into your child's lunchbox, they need to be cut from top to bottom to prevent any



choking hazards.
