History – Children will reach informed conclusions about the events of WW2 and compare them to the current changes in society surrounding COVID-19. Children will explore the impact WW2 had upon society and hypothesise how COVID-19 may now affect society. Children will explore the use of propaganda in WW2 – using both primary and secondary sources including art and literature from both allies and axis sources – and discuss their reliability and compare them to the public information given during COVID-19. Children will know significant dates for WW2

PSHCE Children will explore their sense of community, experiencing loss, rebuilding relationships, re-establishing routines, respecting space and social distance.

Art- We will explore the work of the artist Henry Moore. We will collaboratively recreate a sketch by turning it into a sculpture.

English- Children will explore extracts from Anne Frank's diary and Carrie's War.

Geography- Children explore their global links and their place within the wider world. Children will locate countries and cities on a map whilst also locating significant events and places in the war to show the scale of it being a 'WORLD' war, accompanied with a timeline.

Computing- Children will learn how to create games using coding.
