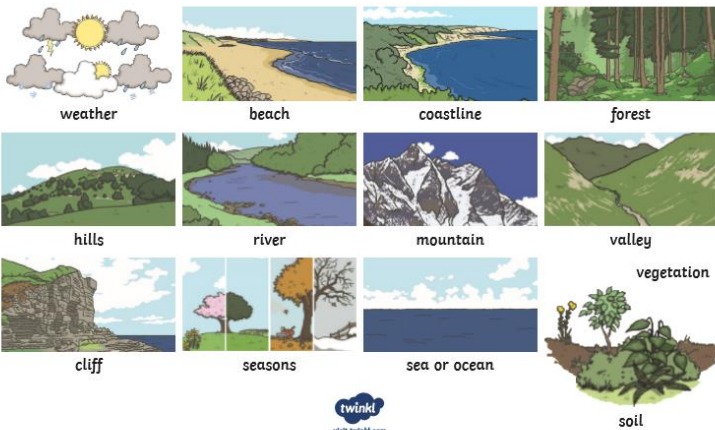

Glossary

germinate- when a seed begins to grow

stem- the main body or stalk of a plant

roots- the part of a plant under the ground which takes up water and nutrients from the soil

human geography- how people and their activities affect an area

physical geography- the natural features of an area

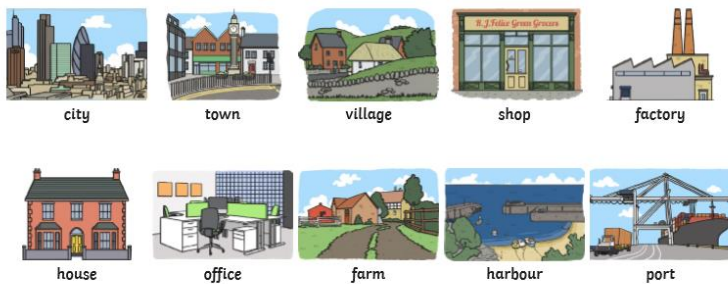
producer- in a food chain plants are called producers because they make their own food using light from the Sun

predator- an animal in a food chain which eats other animals

lever- a simple machine which moves up and down supported by a pivot e.g. a seesaw

slider- a simple mechanism which allows movement from side to side

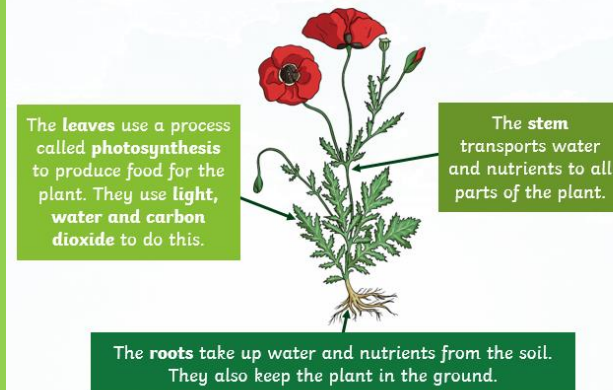

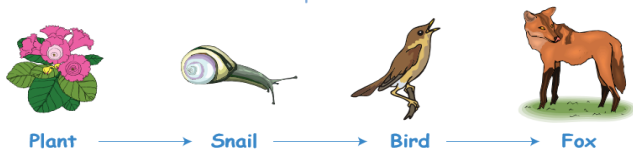
