All children will be going swimming on Monday afternoon. Please ensure that they bring their swimming costume (with hat for children who have long hair) and a towel in a bag to school on Monday



PF

Year 4 will be having PE along with Years 5 & 6 every alternate Tuesday afternoon at Rushford Park. On their PE day, children should wear their PE clothes to school instead of their uniform. PE clothes should consist of shorts or jogging bottoms, a t-shirt and hoodie (if it's cold) and sturdy trainers. We will be going whatever the weather so please bring a waterproof if it is wet.



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Homework

For homework, children should read some pages of their reading book **every night** either with an older family member or independently. Please ensure that their reading record is signed and the pages they have read noted in their book.

Children should also be logging onto MyOn where there is a wide range of books from different genres that will extend their reading ability. This will give them practise not only in reading fluently but also in comprehension, as each book has a quiz to complete.

As Year 4 have a statutory times tables assessment in July, it is essential that children log on to Times Tables Rockstars as often as possible to practise answering questions at speed. They should also practise

multiplication and division questions using Hit the Button on the Topmarks website. Both of these are accessible on tablets, PCs or mobile phones.

Each child also has access to Purple Mash where teachers may post additional tasks to complete at home.
