- Know that human features like houses, roads and bridges are things that have been built by people.
- Know that physical features like seas, mountains and rivers are natural. They would be here even if there were no people around.
- Know that people are connected to places in different ways
- Know that we live in Longsight which is an area of Manchester
- Know that Manchester is a city
- Know that Manchester is in England
- Know that England is country
- Know that the United Kingdom is made up of four countries: England, Ireland, Scotland, Wales
- Know that roads, houses, schools, shops and religious buildings are human features.
- Know that trees, fields and rivers are physical features
- Know that Longsight has mostly human geography
- Know that maps can show us where things are in Longsight
- Know that maps can help us find how to get from one place to another
- Know that old maps can show us what Longsight was like 100 years ago
- Know that many of the buildings have changed
- Know that trams used to run on the main roads
- Know that there were shops 100 years ago and there are still shops now
- Know that some houses are the same as they were 100 years ago
- Know that we can show a route on a map
- Know that we can use symbols to show things we find on our route
- Know that we can describe a journey using words like left, right, straight
- Know that we can use near and far to describe where things are from a starting point
- Know that Longsight has changed in the past 100 years
- Know that the human features have changed because the people have changed
- Know that people moving into an area is called migration
- Know that there are more mosques and different shops because different people live in Longsight
