What is a river?

Geography

Pupils will be finding out about what rivers are by investigating the following questions:

How does the course of the River Axe change from source to mouth?

How does my local river change from source to mouth?

Why are river estuaries such important places for wildlife?

Why are rivers such an important part of the water cycle?

Maths

Pupils will be adding and subtracting 4 digit numbers, using mental strategies and solving word problems.

Computing

Pupils will be learning various coding skills to create a playable game.

PSHE

Pupils will be learning how to make good choices to stay safe and healthy, how to identify risky situations and how to act responsibly

English

Pupils will be writing a chronological recount of their Crowden trip. They will also compose a piece of poetry inspired by our rivers topic.

PE

Pupils will be learning basic swimming techniques and will be working as a team to learn invasion skills while playing basketball.

Music

Pupils will learn how to sing in the correct pitch at the same time while using expression.

Art

Pupils will mixing and matching paint to create different effects and textures.

RE

Pupils will be looking at different religious celebrations and why these are important.

Science

Pupils will be investigating states of matter, how solids, liquids and gasses are different, how they change state and the water cycle.
