

Wonderful Weather

In Maths, we will be developing our understanding of number and place value of numbers to 20. We will continue to learn about addition and subtraction with larger numbers.

In Geography, we will be learning about the four seasons and what they look like in the UK. We will be learning about similarities and differences in weather across the seasons and what extreme weather can look like.

In English, we will be reading *Winston the Worried*. The children will develop their sentence writing by composing a sentence orally before writing it, sequencing events and sentences, and re-reading what they have written to check it makes sense. We will also be focusing on using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

In Science, we will be learning about the four seasons. We will also be making weather observations and using scientific equipment to measure different types of weather.

In Art we will be learning about the artist Kandinsky. We will begin to develop an understanding of primary colour, how these colours can be mixed and experimenting with different tools.
